**Thorough cleaning and hygiene procedures** will be maintained during the festival across the site.

**Hand sanitiser stations** will be available around the festival site.

**Contactless payments** are encouraged.

### What you can do to help us have a COVID safe festival

**Stay at home if you feel unwell.** Please take a Rapid Antigen Test prior to attendance if you have been recently exposed to COVID-19.

**Physical distancing** is recommended where possible.

**Wearing of masks** is recommended where physical distancing is not possible.

**Practise good hand hygiene** with regular handwashing.

### What happens if I can't attend the festival due to testing positive for COVID-19?

If you cannot attend festival events due to testing positive to COVID-19, please contact the festival prior to 10 am on the day of your event to arrange a refund. You will need to provide proof of your positive COVID-19 test result.

## **What happens if the Festival is cancelled by government order?**

If the event is unable to proceed on the advertised date or location by Government order, Mountain Writers Festival reserves the right to reschedule the event and offer a credit or exchange to the rescheduled date or offer a refund request window of 28 days.
